

ACRONYM DEFINITIONS

AVR - Automatic Voltage Regulator

This regulates the output voltage from the generator to a controlled voltage for use.

EGR - Exhaust Gas Recirculation

Recirculates exhaust gas to replace some of the excess oxygen in the pre-combustion mixture.

DOC - Diesel Oxidation Catalyst

Finer than a standard muffler to catch unburnt diesel fuel and excess carbon before entering the atmosphere.

DPF - Diesel Particulate Filter

A honeycomb style filter that catches all unburnt diesel fuel and excess carbon before entering the atmosphere.

SCR - Selective Catalytic Reduction

A similar system to the DPF that includes and injector to add Diesel Exhaust Fluid to create a chemical effect to remove the excess carbon.

DEF - Diesel Exhaust Fluid

A chemical mixture made to be added to diesel exhaust systems to remove any unburnt diesel fuel and carbon deposits.

ETM - Exhaust Temperature Management

A new system that uses a throttle valve to create backpressure and heat to aid the exhaust system in removing carbon.

PCV - Positive Crankcase Ventilation

A point at the top of the engine that allows excess crankcase pressure to leave the system and vent to atmosphere.

SCV - Suction Control Valve

Controls the fuel discharge amount through the high pressure pump the common rail.

ECM - Engine Control Module

Engine computer to regulate all electronic components.

ECU - Engine Control Unit

Same as ECM.

CKP - Crankshaft Position Sensor

Determines the position of the crankshaft by using a magnet by counting the teeth on the gear.

CMP - Camshaft Position Sensor

Determines the position of the camshaft by using a magnet by counting the teeth on the gear.

RPM - Revolutions Per Minute

Engine speed.

HP - Horse Power

Amount of work done.

HZ - Hertz

Unit of frequency.

KVA - Kilovolt Amps

KW - Kilowatts

V - Voltage

A - Amperage

CFM - Cubic Feet per Minute

PSI - Pounds per Square Inch
